

Bunny Ears Inspired by Nature!



You will need:

- * Lots of flowers, foliage, twigs, features etc collected from the garden or on a nature walk
- * A piece of A4 paper
- * Clear craft glue
- * Scissors, pencil
- * String or ribbon

Step by step:

- * Measure the front of your child's forehead from edge to edge
- * On a piece of A4. Draw a rectangular strip about 5 cm thick with two tabs either side
- * Draw some bunny shaped ears, approx 20cm long and cut out this template
- * Organise all of your found nature treasures on the ears until you are happy with the decoration
- * Use any kind of clear drying glue to stick everything down
- * Press the ears between a couple of heavy books to help flatten the leaves and flowers.
- * Pierce holes through the two little tabs with a sharp pencil.
- * Tie string or ribbon on either side
- * Then you're all set!
 Pop on your Peter Rabbit ears!
