





Mrs Tiggy-winkle's Treasure Bracelet

Learn how to make a Mrs Tiggy-winkle's Treasure Bracelet, inspired by nature!

You will need:

- A paperclip
- Scissors
- String
- Some natural materials such as petals, shells and leaves
- Wooden beads (optional)

Step by step:

- Take the paperclip and stretch out most of it leaving the hook of the paperclip
- Press the hook in so it looks like a needle
- Take the string and thread it through the eye of the needle, tie it and cut it
- Go on your nature walk and collect material along the way to add to your friendship bracelet
- Simply use your home made needle to thread in wooden beads if you have them, along with anything you've collected from your nature walk – such as fallen flowers, petals and leaves
- Once you're done, tie the thread together so it forms a bracelet. Encourage your little one to give their bracelet to a friend.

Adult supervision required when using scissors and the paperclip needle
