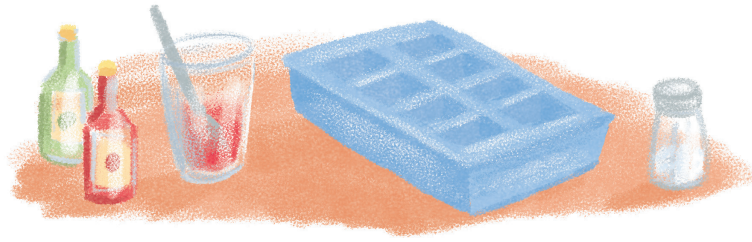


Ice-cube garland



Ask
a grown-up
to help you
with this one.



You will need:

- * A glass of water
- * Food colouring
- * A spoon
- * An ice-cube tray
- * A large plate
- * A freezer
- * Thin string
- * Salt

1. Add several drops of food colouring to the glass of water and stir with a spoon to mix thoroughly.
2. Fill your ice-cube tray with the coloured water, then put it in the freezer.
3. Once the ice cubes have completely frozen, push them out of the tray on to a plate. Arrange them in a line about a centimetre apart.
4. Soak a piece of string in water.
5. Lay the wet string across the middle of the ice-cube line.
6. Sprinkle a little salt on to the top of each cube, where it meets the string.
7. Wait for five seconds, then lift the string. The ice cubes will be attached!
8. Hang your garland up outside and watch it melt!

Experiment with creating a spectacular multi-coloured ice garland using different ice-cube shapes and other food colourings!
